

Ideas to get off of probation FAST

Balance Work and School

- ▶ if you work AND go to college, this strategy can prevent you from burning out.
 - The recommended schedule for a student who is working 20 hours per week and has not been on probation is 12 credits.
 - If you also have family commitments, commute over an hour, or other responsibilities few credits are recommended.

Manage Your Time

- ▶ **How Many Hours Should You Set Aside For Study and Homework Time?**
 - It is recommended that, students spend 2 hours of study time for each hour of class time per week.
 - If you have 12 credits, you should allow 24 hours per week for studying (this includes time for reading, writing papers, preparing projects, and for test preparation).
 - $12 \text{ credits} \times 2 \text{ study hours} = 24 \text{ hours}$
