

2011-2012 Ordean Grant Application Phlebotomy

The Ordean Foundation of Duluth has provided funds for students enrolled in the Lake Superior College (LSC) Phlebotomy program. You are not eligible for the Phlebotomy Ordean Grant if you are taking Phlebotomy as part of another LSC program. You may apply for these funds if you meet the following criteria:

- The student's family income must be no more than the following:

- The student must be a resident in one of the following areas (Ordean "Target Area"):
 - a. Canosia Township
 - b. City of Duluth
 - c. Duluth Township
 - d. Hermantown
 - e. Lakewood Township
 - f. Midway Township (St. Louis County portion only)
 - g. Proctor
 - h. Rice Lake Township
- The student must have lived in the target area for at least one year out of the past three years for purposes other than attending a postsecondary school (college, technical college, university).

If you meet the above criteria, you are eligible to apply for the Phlebotomy Ordean Grant. After you have submitted a complete Ordean Grant application, a Lake Superior College Financial Aid Assistant will notify you in writing regarding the status of your application.

Application Procedure

1. Complete the 2011-2012 Ordean Grant application. Return the completed form to:

2. Include a **signed** copy of your 2010 federal income tax return (Form 1040, 1040A, 1040EZ). If married, include your spouse's tax information. If you are under the age of 24 **and** live with your parent(s), you must include a **signed** copy of your parents' 2010 federal income tax return.

If you (or your parents, if we require their information) did not file a 2010 federal income tax return, attached a signed statement indicating your (or your parents') sources of income for 2010.
3. You will be notified in writing of your application status (approved or denied). Incorrectly completed or incomplete applications will be returned to you for completion.
4. If you are awarded the Ordean Grant for Phlebotomy, all authorized Phlebotomy program charges will be paid by the Ordean Foundation.
5. If you receive other agency funding to cover the costs of this program (for example, WIA, DRS) the Business Services office will charge against the agency funding first. Only charges that are left after agency funding is used can be charged against the Ordean Grant.
