Pre-program Requirements

Successful entry into this program requires a specific level of skill in the areas of English, mathematics, and reading. Program entry will depend, in part, on meeting the prerequisites listed below:

English:

- A score of 86 or higher on the Sentence Skills portion of the CPT, OR
- Completion of ENGL0460 or its equivalent transfer course or higher with a grade of "C" or better.
- If required, ENGL0460 may not be taken concurrently with Semester I coursework.

Mathematics:

- A score of 71 or higher on the Elementary Algebra Skills portion of the CPT, OR
- Completion of MATH0460 or its equivalent transfer course or higher with a grade of "C" or better.
- If required, MATH0460 may not be taken concurrently with Semester I coursework.

Reading:

- A score of 78 or higher on the Reading Comprehension portion of the CPT, OR
 - Completion of READ0465 or its equivalent transfer course or higher with a grade of "C" or better.
 - If required, READ0465 may not be taken concurrently with Semester I coursework.

Required Pre-technical Courses:

Pre-technical course requirements must be completed before the student will be considered for full program entry into Semester I courses.

- o Graduation from a Practical Nursing Program. Program acceptance requires a valid Minnesota Practical Nursing License.
- o The following credits are granted:
 - 15 cr. Nursing
- o The 15 credits in Nursing are granted when the student is accepted into the program. Program acceptance requires a valid Minnesota Practical Nursing License.
- o Licensure as a Practical Nurse in the State of Minnesota.
- o The following coursework (or its equivalent) must also be completed:
