Pre-program Requirements

Successful entry into this program requires a specific level of skill in the areas of English and reading. Program entry will depend, in part, on meeting the prerequisites listed below:

English:

- A score of 86 or higher on the Sentence Skills portion of the CPT, OR
- Completion of ENGL0460 or its equivalent transfer course or higher with a grade of "C" or better.
- If required, ENGL0460 may not be taken concurrently with Semester I coursework.

Reading:

- A score of 78 or higher on the Reading Comprehension portion of the CPT, OR
 - Completion of READ0465 or its equivalent transfer course or higher with a grade of "C" or better.
 - If required, READ0465 may not be taken concurrently with Semester I coursework.

NOTE: Current certification in American Heart Association: BLS Healthcare Provider or American Red Cross: CPR/AED for the Professional Rescuer and First Aid is required prior to beginning the Phlebotomy Internship (MLTN2577). Current certification needs to be documented in the student file prior to beginning the Phlebotomy Internship. ALTH1430 will satisfy this requirement. Background Study approval is required from the State of Minnesota and/or Wisconsin as well as a criminal background study through Verified Credentials, Inc.
